- Discuss what each person is good at (sports, reading, writing etc.) or have difficulty with – can their friends help them? – Working together to help each other gain confidence and get better!



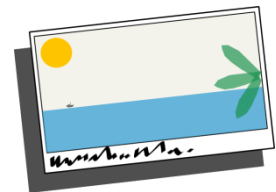
WEEK 5 MEDIA WEEK
